Application of Clifford Edward Jackson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22 day of August  
A. D. 1924, at Ogden Utah County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Not less than one year or  
or no more than twenty  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
At Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clifford Edward Jackson  
I was convicted under the name of Clifford Jackson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary,  
Attempted Sodomy, Grand Larceny,  
Petty Larceny, Vagrancy, Suspicion, Be-  
a Victim of Masturbation I was let off  
lighter on most of these. Also was a  
Patient in Norwalk and Patton State Hospitals  
of Southern California
