Application of Sam Stiers

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah St. Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of Aug. A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh (7) Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hammer presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to ninety (90) days to ten (10) years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Samuel Stiers. I was convicted under the name of Sam Stiers.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Westell.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this.
