Application of Victor Hendrickson.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault to do bodily harm.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of Aug. A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Swenson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Victor Hendrickson. I was convicted under the name of Victor Hendrickson.
