Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8 day of August  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake.  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. A. Iverson, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term 1 yr.  
to 5 years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers, prosecuted the case.
