Application of Victor N. Hendrickson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~life~~ Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Polygamy

✓ Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of October  
✓ A. D. 1925, at Brigham City County of Box Elder  
✓ and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the  
✓ County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

✓ Third-- I was sentenced to imprisonment in the State Prison for an indeterminate sentence of not more than five years, in accordance with section 8086 compiled laws of Utah 1917.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison following an appeal to the State Supreme Court in which the judgment of conviction was affirmed and the original judgment ordered to be enforced, but with a stay of execution of judgment to June 1st, 1926.

✓ Fourth-- Honorable LeRoy B. Young, Dist. Attorney prosecuted the case.
