Application of Dove Smith No. 4628

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with Intent to Murder.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of October A. D. 1925, at Nephi County of Juab and State of Utah, in the Fifth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Burton presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable George H. Lunt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Dove Smith

I was convicted under the name of Dove Smith

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what the record shows.
