I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of assault & attempted murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October  
A. D. 1925, at Nephi County of Juab  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas H. Burton presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
of from 1 to 20 years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable George L. Lunt prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Dove Smith

I was convicted under the name of Dove Smith
