Application of Hans T. Jensen

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows: To go home.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the seventh day of May
A. D. 1925, at Manti City County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Delworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of
Not less than one year or more than twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable C. C. Christensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Hans Thomas Jensen

I was convicted under the name of Hans T. Jensen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Patricia Munley, Francis Welch,
Olmer O. Blenis, Lloyd Miller.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Served two
years at Michigan City, Indiana for
Forgery.
