First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the sixth day of May
A. D. 1925, at Waukegan County of San Pete,
and State of Utah, in Seventh district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one year & twenty
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable A. C. Christensen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is H. T. Jensen,
I was convicted under the name of H. T. Jensen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Patricia Munley & Francis Kelsh sentence
suspended. Lloyd Miller & Elmer O'Brien, terminated.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except in Indiana.
