Application of Oliver Schoonover

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Jan day of 1924 A. D. at Ogden County of Weaver and State of Utah, in 2-district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Donna W. Hume prosecuted the case.
