First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Failure to provide

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of Sept.
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to eighteen months
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable James N. Kimball prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Edward Butterfield
I was convicted under the name of William Edward Butterfield

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above

Note:-- I was given a parole from your institution on Jan. 16, 1926
and have worked continuously for Watson-Buick Auto Co., Ogden,
Utah since April 5, 1926.
