Application of John T. Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination to go to British Columbia, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of October A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Harold M. Stephens presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Frank S. Richards prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John T. Smith

I was convicted under the name of John T. Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: William Bonney, Frank Rodgers and H. A. Gravell

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Yes.
