Application of David A. Griffin.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary (2<sup>nd</sup> Degree).

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October  
A. D. 1924, at Price County of Garfield  
and State of Utah, in 7<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to twenty (1-20) years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is David Albert Griffin.  
I was convicted under the name of David A. Griffin.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except

1. Grand Larceny at Lansing, Kansas.
