Application of George Wilkinson

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Statutory offense.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of June A. D. 1923, at Richfield County of Lewis and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Joseph H. Erickson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate up to five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable N. J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Wilkinson I was convicted under the name of " "

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none
