County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From one to Five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Mrs. Lucille Cairns
I was convicted under the name of Lucille Williams

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
