Application of William A. Strakey No. 4370

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with intent to commit murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of April A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas Burton presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Robert Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William A. Strakey I was convicted under the name of William A. Strakey
