First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Sixth day of May A. D. 1925, at Wpauli County of San Pete and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. J. Korch presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable R. C. Christensen prosecuted the case.
