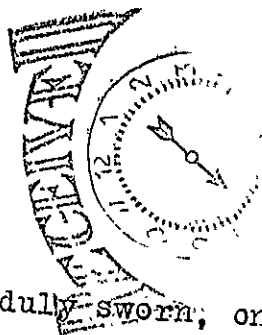

I, Lloyd Miller, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes and says:

That he is confined in the Utah State Prison by virtue of a commitment from the Seventh Judicial District, County of San Peter, on a charge of Burglary, with a recommendation from the Committing Judge of a Parole at the end of Six months.

That my application for Termination of Sentence was considered by the Board of Pardons at their meeting held on June 26th, and July 1st, and same was denied.

That this denial was induced, I believe, by the fact that in the description of his case which appeared before the Board of Pardons, it appeared that he had a recommendation of One (1) Year, while in reality this recommendation was for a Parole at the end of Six Months, and then a Termination.

That the crime for which I plead guilty, was not a severe crime, and that the interests of Justice have been served by my confinement, and no further good can come from my continued incarceration.

That I now have transportation to my home in Indiana, and the assurance of a position when I reach there. That I will have all the advantage of home environment and training, and know that I will never transgress the law again.

That I now apply to the Board of Pardons for a re-hearing of my case, and pray for a conditional Termination to permit me to return to my Mother.

That I was only nineteen years of age when I was sentenced, and did not realize the enormity of the offense. That the time I have been here has taught me to respect the law, and I want to assure the Board that if given the opportunity at this time to return home, no act of mine will ever cause them to regret such action.
