Application of Bert Crofts.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~Prison~~ Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Receiving stolen goods.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of March A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Five years in State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Bert Crofts.

I was convicted under the name of Bert Crofts.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the present one and Burglary. I was convicted in Salt Lake City Utah Dec - 7 - 1921.
