I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Receiving Stolen Goods

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of November A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from 1 to 5 years in Utah Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on Indeterminate Sentence

Fourth-- Honorable C. C. Rogers prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Bert Crafts
