Application of Bert Craft

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Receiving Stolen Goods

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of November A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hutchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to From one year to Five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Bert Thomas Craft I was convicted under the name of Bert Craft

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
