under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Receiving Stolen Property

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of Oct  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Richie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison  
for a term of from 1 to 5 years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable R. R. Rodgers prosecuted the case.
