Application of Will Bard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of July A. D. 1924, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joseph Erickson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. J. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lewis Willbard Bassford I was convicted under the name of Will Bard

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No one

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Meyer in trouble before
