Application of Raymond A. Lund,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence,
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of September
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve six months to Three years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Penitentiary.

Fourth-Honorable Alvon Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Raymond A. Lund,
I was convicted under the name of Raymond A. Lund.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Leland Olson Paroled from the Pench.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
