First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the September 8, day of A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Sam Clausen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Frank Main, I was convicted under the name of Joseph F. Main,

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: - none -

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except adultery,
