Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of March  
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable G. A. Iverson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable A. E. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank Murphy.  
I was convicted under the name of Frank Murphy.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Forgery, California.
