Q Are you prepared for the sentence and judgment of the Court
at this time?

A. Yes sir.

Q How old a man are you, Mr. Murphy?

A. Fifty years old.

Q Where were you born?

A. Ireland.

Q How long have you been in Utah?

A. Four years.
