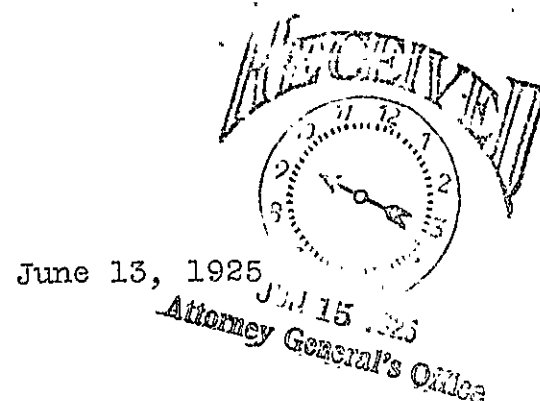

Gentlemen:

In March, 1923, Frank Murphy, upon entering a plea of guilty of the crime of burglary, was sentenced by me to serve an indeterminate term in the State Prison. I later on, as Judge of the District Court, recommended imprisonment for a period of five years.

I am informed that he has made application for pardon and I recommend that the same be granted. I have made inquiry as to his conduct at the State Prison and former Warden James DeVine expresses the opinion that such a recommendation has his full sympathy.

I am also informed that the prisoner is in ill health. I would judge, ~~that~~ from his conduct at the time of sentence, that he probably was at that time not quite normal mentally.
