To the Board of Pardons.

Kind Sirs:-

I pleaded guilty, in Honorable
Judge Rich's court to a Statutory
offense, on the twenty eight day of Sept.
nineteen hundred twenty three; and
was sentenced to an indeterminate
sentence of from one yr. to five yrs.
in the State Prison.

Since my imprisonment here
I have had sufficient time, in which
to realize what a grave offense I
committed against the laws of society;
and I have had ample time in
which to consider my offense. And I
can plainly see now I have made
a mistake.

My punishment here has
sufficed to cause me to feel the
shame and stigma caused by the
crime which I committed, has attached
to my name, aside from the grief

and Father. Furthermore this
punishment, I can truly say cause
you has completely earned my reform-
ation. And any considerations
you afford me, I will appreciate
by my future conduct. I can
further assure you, that what-
ever your judgment may be, I shall
cast no reflections whatever.
