Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the *28th* day of *September*
A. D. *1923*, at *Salt Lake City*, County of *Salt Lake*
and State of Utah, in *Third District* Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable *Judge Hinkle* presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to *indeterminate sentence*
from one to five
and thereafter was imprisoned in the *Utah State Prison*

Fourth-- Honorable *Ed. Ryan* prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is *J. P. Cannon*

mentioned above
