and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Fourth day of October  
A. D. 1923, at Brigham City County of Box Elder  
and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin L. Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joseph Ormond  
I was convicted under the name of Joseph Ormond

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Pete Robert Johnson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary  
Threat Conviction.
