In reply to your letter of the
28th instant:

It will be impossible, under the rules and regulations of the Board of Pardons, to consider the applications of Joe Ormond and Peter Johnson for rehearing, at the special meeting on January 5th. In connection with this matter I quote the following from Rule VIII:

" * * * No application shall be entertained by the Board in any case where an application has been considered and denied by the Board or voluntarily withdrawn, within six months preceding the date ~~of~~ the second application is made, except upon special permission from the Board, based upon some special reasons which must be set forth in writing by the applicant in his application for permission to apply a second time, and such writing subscribed and sworn to."

You will therefore note that in order for the above named to appear before the Board at their next regular session in March, it will be necessary for each of them to file applications for rehearing, together with their reasons therefor in the form of an affidavit.
