
APPLICATION FOR A REHEARING

Now comes the defendants herein, Joe Ormond, and Pete Johnson, and files this ~~and~~ application to the State Board of Pardon, for a rehearing of the former application for a pardon, and ~~that~~ pardon be granted to them and each of them, on the following grounds; that by inadvertance ~~of~~ mistake the necessary proof was not presented at the former application.
