Dear Mr. Cluff:-

Will you please let me know when the State Board of Pardons meet?

Joseph Brumond and Pete Robert Johnson have been in the State Prison some three months longer than the District Judge or the other officials here desired.

These men have been imprisoned since July. The jury convicted them but since the Foreman has written that the evidence did not justify it but that they thought these men were to be held for some other charge. The District Judge has written to Board of Pardons asking that they be discharged at the end of six months. Under that recommendation they should have been dis-charged in January. The District Attorney wrote a letter concurring in the recommendation of Judge Harris. Is it necessary under your practice for some one to come down and present these matters to the Board of Pardons or will these letters be read to the Board when they meet?
