Application of James Cashin

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary, third degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the November day of 1924, at Monticello, County of San Juan and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable County Attorney Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Cashin. I was convicted under the name of James Cashin.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Harold Boyd.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except No.
