Application of George Negomir

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Re-hearing for Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the October 10th day of October A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. C. McGree presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Negomir I was convicted under the name of George Negomir

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None
