Third-- I was sentenced to Term of One to Twenty years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Earl Kline Lund, I was convicted under the name of Earl Kline Lund,

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: David Huveni, and Ollie Peoples,
