I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of April
A. D. 1923, at Piute County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. Christensen Judge presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Walton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Carl Kline Lund
I was convicted under the name of Carl Kline Lund

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
