Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of September

and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of six months to three  
years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney Evans. prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Edward Wells  
I was convicted under the name of John E. Wells.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except never under arrest before.
