County and State aforesaid, Honorable Jas. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jas. B. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Jose Aguilar
