Application of Howard Dean Linsley,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Rehearing, Conditional Termination, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery,

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Seventh day of March, A. D. 1923, at Ogden, County of Weber, and State of Utah, in 2nd. Judicial District, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kinball, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to life, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Howard Dean Linsley, I was convicted under the name of Howard Dean Linsley,

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Guy Rollins, and Ira Brown,

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the present one,
