Gentlemen:

I have investigated quite carefully the case of James E. Randall and Frank M. Randall, who were convicted in Emery County, State of Utah, and sentenced to the State prison for stealing one yearling steer calf, the property of James Liddell. Mr. Liddell has been in my office and I have seen the petitions signed by numerous people asking for the parole of these two Randall men. I believe that a good purpose would be served in the paroleing of these and that from here on out no violations such as this will be made by these men. I have been approached by at least twenty-five of the responsible men of Carbon and Emery Counties asking me to do something towards the paroleing of these men and after these requests I have made some investigations of their life and their conduct and especially in the particular transaction for which they were sentenced to the prison. Taking all of these matters into consideration, permit me now to recommend to you that these men be paroled at this time.
