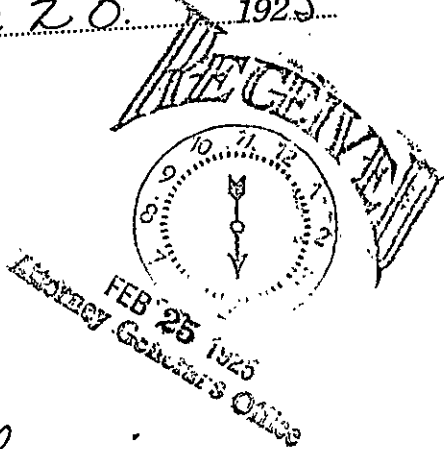


Salt Lake City, Utah, Feb. 20 1925

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate

Sentence
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Pope prosecuted the case.
