

Salt Lake County, Utah, by this information, of the crime of Burglary in the second degree, committed as follows, to-wit:

That the said James Parker, at Salt Lake County, Utah, on the 21st day of September, 1923, in the night time of said day, break and enter the dwelling house located near L. A. & S. L. Railroad Depot, Garfield, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, said dwelling house being then and there occupied by Paul K. Randall, with intent, the goods and chattels then and there being in said dwelling house, then and there wilfully, unlawfully and feloniously to steal, take and carry away; contrary to the provisions of the Statute of the State aforesaid, in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Utah.

Second Count: Did commit the crime of Grand Larceny as follows, to-wit:

That the said James Parker, at the time and place aforesaid, did wilfully, unlawfully and feloniously steal, take and carry away from the possession of Paul K. Randall, against the will of the said Paul K. Randall, personal property, as follows, to-wit: One saxophone, one suitcase, one sheepskin lined coat, one quilt, one flash light and one savings bank of the value of Two Hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, the said personal property being then and there the property of and in the possession of the said Paul K. Randall; contrary to the provisions of the Statute of the State aforesaid in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Utah.
