and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of February
A. D. 1922, at Brigham City County of Boxelder
and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. A. Law presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, on 11th day of July,
1923, having appealed and been out on bonds.

Fourth-- Honorable LeRoy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Cecil C. Monroe
I was convicted under the name of Cecil C. Monroe
