I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of January A. D. 1923, at Tooele County of Tooele and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months to three years in the state prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for 21 months

Fourth-- Honorable J. B. Gordon prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Richard D. Flannigan I was convicted under the name of

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one and if released will leave the State at once
