and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16 day of January  
A. D. 1923, at Tooele County of Tooele  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable \_\_\_\_\_ presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months to three years  
and have been here over two years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable John B. Gordon prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Richard D. Turner  
I was convicted under the name of Richard D. Hannigan
