

Application of Chas. Friedman Mar. 21, 1925

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of March A. D. 1924, at Price Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Sentence 1 yr. to 20 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Chas. Friedman I was convicted under the name of Chas. Friedman.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except I have served a sentence in Colo. State Reformatory.
