and State of Utah, in second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Dist Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one (1) to five (5) years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison
