To the Honorable Board of Pardons,  
Utah State Prison,  
Salt Lake City, Utah.

In re: The State of Utah vs. Sam Addleson:

Gentlemen:

The State prosecuted the defendant, Sam Addleson ,  
upon an information filed against him by the District Attorney  
of this Judicial District, charging him with the crime of Rape,  
a felony, which the information alleges was committed as follows:

The said defendants, on July 25, 1921, at the  
County of Weber, State of Utah, wilfully, unlawfully  
and feloniously accomplished an act of sexual inter-  
course with a female, not the wife of either of them,  
to-wit, Amy Ekins, a girl seventeen years of age, the  
will and power of resistance of said Amy Ekins being  
then and there overcome by the giving and administra-  
tion to said Amy Ekins of intoxicating, narcotic and  
anaesthetic substances by the said defendants for the  
purpose of preventing resistance on the part of said  
female, and the defendants did in the manner aforesaid  
forcefully and violently carnally know, abuse and  
ravish said Amy Ekins;

Contrary to the form of the statute in such case  
made and provided, and against the peace and dignity  
of the State of Utah.

On November 16th. 1921, a jury duly empanelled  
in the above entitled action, brought in a verdict as follows:

"We the jury empanelled in the above entitled  
action, find the defendant Sam Addleson Guilty of Rape"
